1. GUEST LECTURE ON CAREER IN ARMED FORCES

A guest lecture for class X and XII was organised in conference room on 18 Feb 2021.Lt Ajay Yadav from Gorkha Rifles motivated the students of grade 10th and 12th, to join the defense services through his enthralling presentation. He also focused on role of self discipline in our daily life, he brought out the importance of self discipline in the life of a student. Everyone has similar 24 hours, the difference lies how effectively a person uses his time and self discipline and intrinsic motivation only propel a person towards fulfilment of their goals or achieve something extraordinary in life.

2. PARIKSHA PE CHARCHA

The 4th edition of 'Pariksha Pe Charcha', the unique interactive program of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi was held through online mode during 18 February to 14 March 2021 for children studying in classes IX to XII, teachers and parents. adhering to the COVID-19 protocols. Approximately 280 students of classes IX to XII, 40 teachers and 15 parents participated in an online creative writing competition conducted at https://innovateindia.mygov.in/ppc-2021/ on various topics. All the participants received an e-certificate signed by Director, NCERT.

3. **DEALING WITH MISBEHAVIOR IN CLASSROOM**

A talk on **Dealing with Misbehavior in classroom** was conducted by Mrs Hema Kalakoti on 15 February, school counselor Arti Gupta attended the same. The main aim of the session was to make teachers aware of the reasons behind such behaviour and what actions teachers can take to handle it .During the talk the reasons for such behaviour of children were covered ranging from seeking attention, revenge, lack of confidence and physiological factors. In the session, the speaker gave various strategies which can be adopted by teachers to successfully handle such students. These were aimed to encourage teachers to develop their own teaching style promoting responsibility, cooperation, courage and self esteem. The speaker covered the lecture lucidly and shared various practical tips to manage the misbehaviour of children in classroom

4. **SAMC MEETING**

SMC was organized at APS Gwalior on 16 February 2021, the main agenda was budget for the financial year 2021-22. The meeting was presided over by Brig. Sushim Biswas Commander 72 inf. Bde, chairman APS Gwalior, many important decisions related to financial budget and further development of the school were taken during the meeting.

5. ONLINE WORKSHOP ON THE TOPIC HOW TO DEVELOP SCHOOL AS LEARNING ORGANIZATION

An online session, on the topic "How to develop schools as learning organization", was organised by COE Bhopal MP, on 17 February, 21. Mr Sarbeswar Samal from Bhuvneshwar was the resource person for this enriching learning experience. Mrs Vivian Vice Principal, attended this session on behalf of APS Gwalior. He explained the importance of promoting learning culture in the school ecosystem. According to him every employee in the school must be in receptive mode to be a lifelong learner who are ready to adopt and adept as per the need posed by time, place and circumstances as per the needs raised from the organisation. He further explained that teaching and learning in the school must be aligned with the vision and mission of the school. While expressing his views on creating and supporting continuous professional development of all The session was very interactive, In the end, Mr. Samal was keen to know learning outcomes from the participants.

6. ONLINE WORKSHOP ON ELEMENTS OF ADOLESCENCE EDUCATION IN TEACHING OF DIFFERENT SUBJECTS

An online workshop was organized by COE, Bhopal on 18th Feb, 2021. It was attended by Mrs. Suman Sharma, TGT Biology, on the topic "Elements of Adolescence Education in Teaching of Different Subjects." The resource person was Dr. Dinesh C. Sharma. This being an interactive session brought into light various important aspects of adolescents like effects of physical changes oo adolescent minds. The problems they face like personal adjustments, stress, and juvenile delinguent behaviour. The major health issues were like psycho-social and emotional health challenges that obstruct the normal pace of their development were also discussed. The resource person suggested few steps which can be taken to get quality human resources for the country: these will include not only academic skill but development of Life skills (Thinking skills, social skills and emotional skills) is very important too. The key messages were Review of syllabi and textbooks of all subjects to identify the scope of integration of elements of adolescence education. Incorporation of adolescence education contents in the syllabi and textbooks in revision. Preparation of prototype material for facilitating effective integration education adolescent. Integration of all such elements and nrequired transactional methods in the teacher education process. Overall an effective learning opportunity with many take away's.

7. ONLINE FDRC WORKSHOP ON APPS RESTRUCTURED CURRICULUM

An official workshop was conducted by APS GWALIOR team members – Mr. Arvind Singh Sikarwar (Principal) and Mrs. Chanderkala (CPW) as cluster 7-master trainers at the FDRC platform on 18 Feb 2021under the mentorship of dignified FDRC faculty members focusing on one of the four pillars of APPS restructured curriculum that is 'How to Teach?'. Under which pedagogies for Pre School – Emergent Literacy and Activity Based Learning were highlighted and discussed. For accomplishing the vision of APPS for developing a Child Centered Developmentally Appropriate curriculum to ensure seamless transition of Pre School Learners from LKG to UKG to Class 1 in alignment to NEP 2020, ECCE ,NCERT and NCF 2005, there is a need to develop qualified, competent and equipped facilitators with creative ideas ,innovative pedagogies and having

awareness of required scenario. So in service training has to be provided to educators and for which the FDRC is playing pivotal role to develop administrative functionaries in the form of Cluster Master Trainers for the same to be implemented into practice with zeal and enthusiasm for full -fledged success. Working in the same direction, as a **cluster master trainer**, **APS Gwalior Principal and CPW** presented a well -planned and very detailed topic specified presentation which was heartily appreciated by FDRC senior faculty Mrs. Shayda Rana. 8. ONLINE FDRC WORKSHOP ON INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

COE Bhopal organized a remote workshop on Inclusive Education, which was attended by Special Educator Ms. Swati S Bhambore. The resource person Madam Seema Tripathi gave an enlightening presentation on the above topic. Through her one hour session she broke various myths about Inclusion. Madam highlighted that, all children can participate at all time in school, Education is for all, it is meant protection of rights of all learners. Education must also include identification of skills, development of social consciousness, and prepare all learners for new challenges, development of brotherhood in them and in a nutshell to improve quality of education.

She shared the Principles of inclusive education and suggested reforms in curriculum to be included to cater the diverse needs of learners.

This was an informative session to update the knowledge of teachers.

9. ON LINE WORKSHOP ON STRESS MANAGEMENT

An online talk on **Stress Management Techniques** was conducted on **24 February 2021**, by COE Panchkula, Dr.Rakesh Sehgal was the resource person for the same, on behalf of APS Gwalior, School Counselor Mrs Arti Gupta attended the webinar. The resource person explained various stress reduction techniques. His talk included tips to reduce the intensity of emotional reaction towards a stressor, like not to over react in a difficult situations, breaking down the event and finding practical solution by being mindful, preparing well in advance, be vigilant to plan the thoughts and by filtering irrelevant information or thoughts each day, replacing a negative thought with a positive one and remain focused on the task which is most important.

Planning ahead has an important role to keep the stress at bay. Being responsible individual and sharing of responsibility where ever possible plays a big role to manage stress effectively

Maintaining a healthy lifestyle spending some time on physical activity secretes calming hormones in the body and helps in stress reduction. Similar effect painting, dancing and listening to music has. Nutrition and spirituality also helps to make an individual more productive and peaceful, not to forget the role of yoga and meditation for the same. The ultimate goal is a balanced life, which can be achieved by effective time management with appropriate time for work, quality time for family and social relationships, relaxation and recreation as well along with some active social involvement as well.

Six steps for making an effective lesson plan were also discussed. As an educator applying innovative pedagogies make the learner more motivated during classes and makes the topics more comprehendible for them, especially in the subject like Social Sciences in which many learners find it more of theory based.

11. ONLINE WORKSHOP ON GAMIFICATION IN LEARNING

COE Bhopal, organized an online session on the topic Gamification in Learning, Dr. Rajesh Chandel was the resource person for the same, Ms Neelima Tomar attended the same.

As per various researches it is well established fact that children learn better when made to learn and understand through games, hance Gamification has an important role for the same. Gamification is the use of game design elements in non-game contexts.

The resource person explained in a well-structured manner how the principles of gamification can be integrated into education and learning process.

Indeed a very comprehensive webinar very appropriate for all educators in order to adapt themselves with new era education facilitation skills.

12. ONLINE FDRC WEBINAR ON APPS RESTRUCTURING CURRICULUM

After the rigorous online training of about a month on **APPS Restructured Curriculum**, a webinar was organized by FDRC on March 3rd 2021, to further enlighten the cluster wise master trainers, it laid down the importance of next level physical trainings in coming days, weeks & months, these will be organised within the clusters, with lead master trainers taking initiatives to organise the same.

School Principal Mr. Arvind K Sikarwar and Special Educator Ms. Swati S Bhambore attended the session to prepare themselves for further action.

MD AWES Maj. Gen. R.K. Raina, made certain points clear towards upcoming days of March 8th & 9th to be allocated for training PS1 level teachers, 10th & 11 march to be dedicated for PS1 and 12th & 13th of March for PS 2 level teachers further taking it towards seamless transition to APS. He advised, Principals of APS & APPS to bifercate the teachers in 3 categories before 31st March, I category would be Trainer teachers, who can move around and train teachers within the cluster, II category would be of teachers who can support trainings within the schools itself, and III category would be of teachers who are either resistant to change or new to the system.

This is to ensure quality pre-school education. MD sir put emphasis on the implementation of Inclusive Education program in full swing from 1st April 2021 it has to be in close association with other schools within the edges of AWES. This would serve as an important indicator towards ensuring quality education for all learners within the APS ecosystem. All APS schools to appoint counsellors and special educators as well to ensure to cater diverse learning needs of learners, the

schools are further suggested to liaison with other agencies which are working in the field of disability education for further guidance and understanding.

There has to be provision for giving appropriate opportunities to gifted children as well also the schools have to imbed in their system the skill development program for learners in school.

The point of upgradation of internet facility either by using LAN services or centralised services through a service provider within the school system, he further brought attention for the need of being vigilant towards cyber security and strengthening the security of school website by SSL certification and installation of firewall and also to ensure password safety protocols.

upgradation of teachers as well as students is an important need of the hour to ensure this, it is recommended that each day a 4-5 minute content must be shared using web browsing informational websites to keep students abreast with global scenario in various fields.

He also shared the proposal of Learning Management System in upcoming days.

Further queries from all 12 clusters were taken up.

This webinar was an important milestone to take a leap in training and implementation of APPS restructured curriculum in alignment with NEP 2020.

13. ONLINE FDRC WORKSHOP ON APPS RESTRUCTURED CURRICULUM

An intensive 3 days in school workshop was organized by APS Gwalior, under the guidance of FDRC, the objective of this workshop was to orient and sensitize the teachers about the APPS restructured curriculum and making them aware about the goals and objectives of the same along with giving an insight about seamless transition.

The Workshop was facilitated by Master trainers Principal Arvind K Sikarwar and CPW Chandrakala along with Special Educator Swati S Bhambore. The workshop was very much informative and full of knowledge, it brought about the need of keeping regular contact and maintaining connections with the PS 2 level students so that they do not feel uncomfortable or fearful when they come in grade 1. it made parcipants understand about different pedagogical processes, need of knowing the individual differences amongst the kids, understanding their basic and specific needs and attain tools and techniques according to them to educate them keeping their age in mind etc. This workshop has helped to understand the paradigm shift in the their role as facilitators.

A total of 35 teachers from ASHA school, APPS school and APS Gwalior attended the same along with principals of APPS school Gwalior.




