The objective behind this activity was to impart the moral values to be followed in life to become a good human being. Students came to know about the importance of kindness, empathy and honesty in their lives.








WEBINARS/ WORKSHOPS FOR FACULTY ENRICHMENT

(A) FDRC WEBINAR NO. 27 PEDAGOGY FOR INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

FDRC five-day webinar on "Pedagogy for Inclusive Education" from 20- 24 September was attended Mrs. Sonali Mangal (PRT) Mrs. Renu Singh (PRT), and Mrs. Swati S Bhambore (Special Educator) of Army Public School Gwalior. The workshop focused on the pedagogical processes for Children with Special Needs. It revolved around the UDL (Universal Design of Learning) and IEP (Individual Education Plan).

This workshop enabled the participant learner teachers to be well equipped with differentiated strategies to be implemented within the class room and to make the curriculum more student-friendly. It further trained the participant educators to tailor the curriculum as per the needs of the students, while using activity-based and experiential learning based pedagogy.






FDRC WEBINAR NO 28 DEVELOPING SCIENTIFIC TEMPER AT TGT LEVEL

He also emphasized the need for teachers to remain lifelong learners and





adapt themselves as per new pedagogical changes as stated in the new education policy. He also suggested teacher participants to imbibe the learnings from the workshop and incorporate them in their classroom transactions

These presentations aimed at updating the knowledge of participant teachers on the history of the Indian education system, salient features of NEP 2020 and its vision towards the year 2030.

Through their sessions the resource persons highlighted the importance of Art integration with core academic subjects, along with need and importance of inquiry based teaching, tips to foster creativity and development of scientific temper in learners, achieving conceptual understanding beyond the text, tools and techniques of assessment, role of phonetics in correct pronunciation and reinforcement of reading skills in learners.

This workshop enabled participant teachers to align themselves with the vision and mission of New Education Policy 2020.


(E) WEBINAR 30 - PGT -MATHS

The webinar started with the opening address of MD AWES, Delhi. Later, the first session was conducted by Dr R S Panwar, Additional Dir (Academics) on NEP 2020. The other enriching sessions conducted were "Maths Made Easy" by Dr Hukum Singh, DSEM, NCERT(Retd), "Enhancing Maths Score" by Dr Dhirendra Shukla, RIE Bhopal, "Teaching of Math's through ICT" by Prof (Dr) PK Chauraisia, RIE Ajmer , "Elimination of Maths Phobia" by Prof (Dr) Ashutosh Wazalwar, NCERT and "Professional Scopes of opting Math's in class XI" by Mrs Mrs Manisha Baraskar, TGT Math's, APS Kirkee. The most interesting session was conducted by Dr Hukum Singh, DSEM, NCERT (Retd), who is expert in teaching Mathematics by using Math Lab Activities. According to him: 'Mathematics is the easiest, practical and vocational subject". He emphasized on the "Learning by Doing".

This webinar helped the teachers to revisit and refresh important concepts of Math, involved in making Mathematics teaching more learner-friendly.



FDRC organized webinar no. 32 Computer Science at TGT Level from 18th and 20 to 22 October 2021. Mr Manas Mukherjee, TGT, Computer and Mr Rajveer Singh, PRT, Computer participated in the same from Army Public School Gwalior.

This workshop focused at understanding the pedagogical changes as required in the teaching of computer science in classes VI to IX as per NEP 2020. It included an insightful session on Extended Reality by resource person Ms Neeru Mittal, NCERT & CBSE Resource Person for Computer Science. It is a term referring to all real-and-virtual combined environments and human-machine interactions generated by computer technology and wearables. Teaching of Computer Science for different classes was also conducted by APS Srinagar, APS Binnaguri, APS Khadakvasla, and APS Lucknow. Interesting sessions on Instructional Designing was conducted by Prof (Dr) Angel Rathnabai S of CIET, NCERT and by Dr Seema Negi, Director Sanjeevani Global School Mumbai" on Education 4.0. The workshop aimed to develop the innovative and ever advancing temperament amongst the computer teachers across Army Public Schools.
