

In order to promote scientific research and project based learning among students, APS Gwalior organised a guest lecture for students of science stream and NTSE aspirants on 9th November 2021. The guest speaker for the session was Mr N.K. Gupta ex, Dy. Director & Project Director (Cryogenics) LPSC/ ISRO and an esteemed alumnus of Jiwaji University Gwalior.

He was formally welcomed by Mr Arvind Kumar Sikarwar principal Army Public School Gwalior. Mr Gupta briefed the students on cryogenic engines, aerospace propulsions. He showed students videos of the launching of the GSLV MK II vehicle and GSLV G -5 flight. In his lecture he explained all the processes that are involved in the manufacturing of turbo machines. After explaining the manufacturing process he illustrated various materials.

He motivated the students to do subject specific research and projects to develop deeper understanding. He also encouraged students to explore new career opportunities in scientific fields.

(J) ONLINE VEER GATHA PROJECT IN THE HONOUR OF GALLANTRY AWARD WINNERS



WEBINARS/ WORKSHOPS FOR FACULTY ENRICHMENT

(A) FDRC WEBINAR NO. 33- INCLUSIVE EDUCATION PHASE II- REMEDIAL INTERVENTIONS FOR STUDENTS WITH LEARNING PROBLEMS

An online five days' workshop on Inclusive Education Phase II-Remedial Interventions for Students with Learning Problems' was organised by FDRC from 25th to 29th October 2021. Mrs Neelu Dixit PRT English, Mrs Neelima Tomar PRT Maths and Mrs Nisha Gautam PRT Hindi were detailed from Army Public School Gwalior to attend the same.

The workshop started with the opening address by MD AWES Maj. Gen. R.K. Raina.

The resource person Mrs Venella Ravi and Dr Taniya Gupta focused on an Inclusive approach towards enhancing educational attainment and learning outcomes of underachieving children across Army Public Schools and also gave guidelines for its implementation.

The resource person Mrs Arushi Kapoor informed participant teachers on diagnostic tools to understand learning needs in students and remedial strategies in Mathematics. She also sensitised that diagnostic testing is skill based. Arithmetic operations talk about skills and ELPS (Experience, Language associated with that concept, Pictorial and Symbolic).

The Resource person Mrs Kamayani Joshi (PGT English) explained the teachers on 'Diagnostic Testing' in English subject and how' Remedial Teaching' has to be done in order to achieve expected competencies in core academic skills such as literacy and numeracy.

The resource person Mrs Meenu Manhas focused on the diagnostic testing and remedial strategies in Hindi subject. Her session focused on specific stretegies to bridge the learning gap of CWSN (Children with Learning Disability) to attain the minimal level of learning.

The webinar enabled the participant teachers with the strategies to support the students with learning problems.




(B) FDRC WEBINAR NO 34- TGT ENGLISH

He discussed about CBSE and NCERT provisions along with New Education Policy. Dr. Seema Negi (Director Sanjeevani Global School Mumbai) took an informative session on 'English Teaching and Methodology'. Mrs. Sunayna Gupta (Retd. Principal) gave an enriching presentation on 'Rules of English Grammar'. Dr. Pushpalata (HOD English BITS Pilani) enlightened the trainee teachers on "Student Engagement in ELT Classroom". Dr. Sanjeev Arora the resource person from Central University of Rajasthan gave an informative presentation on the topic "Framing Effective Multiple Choice Questions". He also led a group discussion about the framing of MCQs as per new examination pattern.

The workshop included specific sessions on Teaching of English in classes VI to X. Md AWES Major General Raina in his closing address took an oral feedback about the clarity, utility and quality of the content delivered by various resource persons. He put an emphasis on the role of education and educators in developing employability skills in students highlighting the need for a creative outlook in studies.

The workshop successfully updated the participant English language educators to improvise on their teaching methodology and implement creative ideas within their classes to make learning more accessible to all learners.




(C) CBSE WEBINAR NO 2: PLANNING TO ASSESS THE LEARNING

CBSE has been organizing a series of webinars to train teachers on 'Holistic Assessment of learners'. In continuation to the same, 'Planning to Assess Learning' was organised on 26th October 2021. Mrs Chandrakala PRT, Mrs Renu Tomar PRT, Mrs Padmaja Gupta TGT, Mr Dharamveer Singh PRT, Mrs Saroj Devgan TGT and Mrs Mamta Naruka PGT participated in this training webinar from Army Public School Gwalior. The webinar started with the brief information regarding the need of thorough planning to assess the holistic development of students. Resource person Deepti Sawhney, CEO, Founder Mahattattva stressed on continuous and holistic assessment as stated in New Education Policy. The teaching pedagogy must include assessment tools as assessment of learning is a constant requirement to facilitate learning among the students. She made an emphasis on rubrics and to make children familiar with the rubrics. She also elaborated on the three parts of Progressive Pedagogy that are understanding information, Manipulating information and Generating information, benefits of Progressive Pedagogy, Rubrics and types of Rubrics.

This workshop enabled educators to prepare themselves as per the New Education Policy.

(D) FDRC WEBINAR NO 35 PGT BIOLOGY




