

Mrs Nisha Bhadoria ,PRT, Army Public School Gwalior, participated in FDRC Webinar-38,Foundation Level for APS and APPS teachers based on APPS Restructured Curriculum from 23 to 26 November 2021. The Webinar started with the opening address by Maj Gen R.K. Raina, MD AWES. Later, the FDRC faculty focused on one of the four pillars of APPS Restructured Curriculum 'How to Teach?' During the session the pedagogies for Pre School-Emergent Literacy and Activity Based Learning were highlighted and discussed. Innovative, activity based and experiential pedagogy is essential to accomplish the vision of APPS. APPS Restructured Curriculum professes to develop a Child Centered, Developmentally Appropriate curriculum to ensure seamless transition of Pre School learners from PSI to PSII and in Class. (B) WEBINAR 39 - CASE STUDY "AN APPROACH TO UNDERSTAND THE GIFTED"



She explained the diverse modes, channels and types of gifted and talented children. On 24 Nov 2021 the session was taken by Dr Vandana Saxena, Associate Professor, and Central institute of Education. She discussed about child psychology. Afternoon session was taken by a team from Jnanaprabadini, Pune. The team discussed about the education pattern for gifted children. On 25 Nov 2021, the session was taken by a team of Venkatesh trust of Education and Excellence. They explained about the



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identification and difference between gifted and talented child. The afternoon session was taken by Mr Subhash Chander, Associate Professor, Central Institute of Education Department. He discussed about nurturing creativity in Indian classrooms. On 26 Nov 2021 Dr Vandana Saxena, Associate Professor, Central Institute of Education explained about significant dimensions and also spoke about parent as partners in the Gifted Education journey. The closing address was given by Maj Gen R K Raina, MD, AWES. The entire webinar was very informative for all the counsellors and teachers.

(C) WORKSHOP ON IDENTIFICATION OF CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS


An enriching workshop on Identification of Children with Special Needs was organized by HQ Southern Command Pune on 03 December 2021 on the occasion of International Day of Persons with Disabilities. Mrs Chandrakala Soni, Primary Wing Coordinator and Mrs Swati Bhambore, Special Educator of Army Public School Gwalior participated in this online/offline workshop.

The workshop was an eye opening session for all. It started with the session of renowned practicing pediatric neurologist Lt. Col. Sachendra Badal and Child and Adolescent psychiatrist Col Arun Singh Yadav along with ENT and neuro-otology Lt. Col. Abha Kumari Command Hospital (SC) Pune.

The theme for the workshop was Early Detection and Early Intervention for successful outcomes. Resource persons sensitized the learner educators with signs to identify the disabilities in children.

They also advised all to understand the need of changing perspective towards children with disabilities, rather than looking what the child cannot do. The educators must try and do what they can do for the development of the child. Teachers must take the initiative to orient parents on the importance of early identification followed by successful management of the disability Various case management studies were also presented there to provide deeper understanding to all on different kinds of disabilities.








WORKSHOP ON IDENTIFICATION OF CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS DATE
