(D) INTRA-CLASS ENGLISH CALLIGRAPHY COMPETITION-

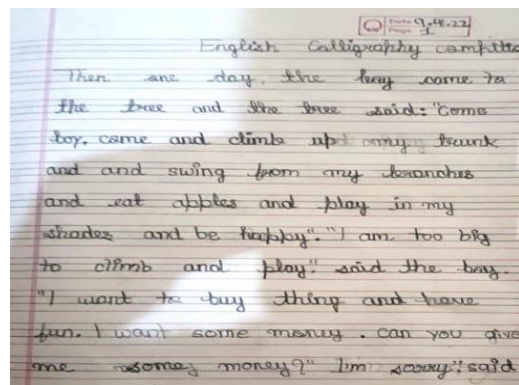
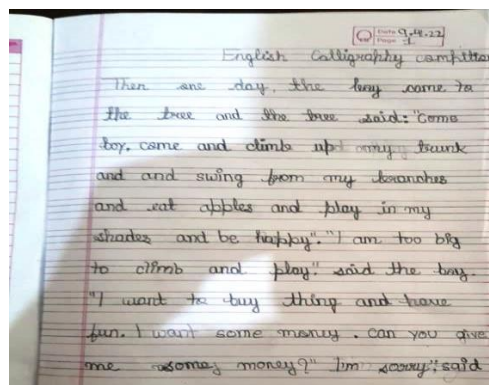

The webinar started with the opening address by MD AWES Maj General RK Raina.

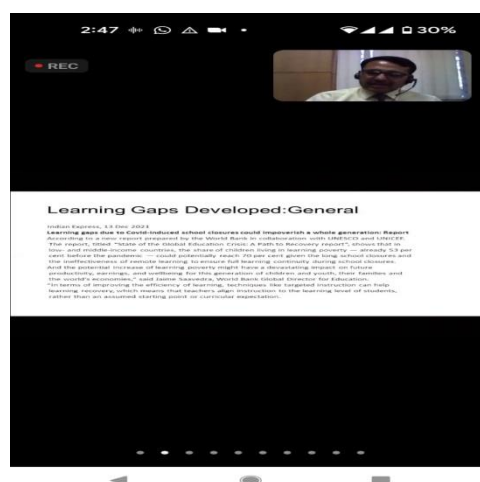
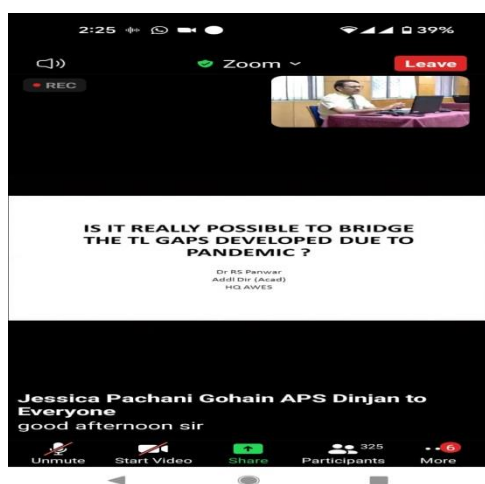
The other sessions were taken by Mrs Lakshmi Hariharan (Madras Dyslexia Association) laid emphasis on demystifying dyslexia, supporting students with SLD after that Mrs Shyda Rana focussed on NEP 2020 & APPS Restructured Curriculum, Dr Bhuvana Vasudevan (Founder & Chief Mentor Pondicherry Dyslexia Association) took a session on Early Identification & Intervention for Specific Learning Disability. The next part of the session was taken by Mrs Anjali Bapat, Special Educator APS Dehu Rd, Pune. She gave her lecture on Supporting Students with SLD at the Foundational Level in APS.

The theme for the workshop was Early Detection and Early Intervention for successful outcomes. Resource persons sensitized the learners/ educators with signs to identify the disabilities in children. They also advised all to understand the need of changing perspective towards children with disabilities, rather than looking what the child cannot do. The educators must try and do what they can do for the development of the child. Teachers must take the initiative to orient parents about the importance of early identification followed by successful management of the disability. Various case management studies were also presented there to provide deeper understanding to all on different kinds of disabilities. Different techniques of assessment i.e. observation, assignment, rating scale, rubrics, anecdotal records, audio-video recording and portfolios were suggested for the better development of students. Teachers were suggested to learn the skill of questioning and enquiry which would help in developing thinking and problem-solving skills among the students.

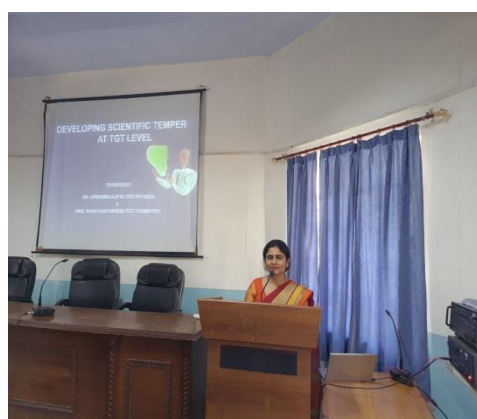
