It was a great learning experience for all the participants and students who viewed the competition.

(e) CLASS CONDUCT IN ROBOTICS/ATAL TINKERING LAB

Army Public School Gwalior proudly set its steps into the noble mission of knowledge enhancement. With a vision to cultivate one million child innovators in India, Atal Innovation Mission by NITI Aayog and Government of India envisaged a novel programme - establishment of Atal Tinkering Laboratories in schools across the country. Some activities conducted between 04-07-2022 to 07-08-2022 are as follows:-

Basics of AI: In this class students got to know about the basics of Artificial Intelligence. Students have become able enough to differentiate between Artificial Intelligence and normal computers. They were explained about AI with the help of AI games.

Demonstration of robots and robotic components: In this class the students were shown the practical demonstration of some robots like Robo Crane, Hexabot, Transporter vehicle, etc. and were explained the working of each robot. They were shown the separate components of each robot and other important parts of Robotics.

LED Sequential Control: It was first basic project of ATL in which students were demonstrated how to blink LEDs, using programming in a particular fashion. In this project students learned about breadboards, circuits, Arduino Uno, Jumper Wires, LEDs, Resistors, etc.

Introduction to Python: In this class the students were given some basic introduction of a high level programming language Python. They were imparted knowledge how to install Python on any computer and how to start Python. Robotics Faculty has started to teach Python Language Basics and the School will proceed gradually by conducting more innovative classes







CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL LEADERS (WEBINAR NO.7)
