
## ACTIVITIES OF THE STUDENTS

#### (A) NIAS(ALC) PROGRAM FOR GIFTED STUDENTS

AWES organized a pilot project for gifted students of class V and VI, through NIAS (ALC).For this project, Army Public School Gwalior made a committee of one Coordinator and two Facilitators. In this committee, Mrs. Padmaja Gupta was registered as Coordinator and the two Facilitators were Mrs.Gargi Shukla and Ms Neelima Tomar who facilitated the topics of Science and Mathematics. NIAS selected 4 students from the school, for online sessions and rest 32 students were selected for offline mode, however 8 more students were also added on the request of their parents. In this project, all the twelve Online sessions were conducted by Mr. Sudarshan, who is the National Coordinator of NIAS(ALC). These sessions were conducted from 17th September 2022 to 14th December 2022. 10 Offline NIAS(ALC) classes were also conducted by both the registered facilitators.

All the NIAS(ALC) classes were informative and interactive. The students showed100 percent participation in advanced learning of higher classes like Atomic structure, Electronic Configuration, Electromagnetic waves, Grid Multiplication etc

## (H) DEVELOPMENT OF FLORICULLTURE GARDEN

Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR) has launched nation-wide 'Floriculture Mission' wherein CSIR-National Botanical Research Institute (NBRI), Lucknow is the coordinating organization. The CSIR-Floriculture Mission is a farm-based income generating enterprise having high potential to earn foreign exchange and generate employment for rural and urban youths. The mission has several activities such as – development of new floral varieties, expansion of area under floricultural crops, urban floriculture, post-harvest and value addition technologies, apiculture, variety registration and release, establishing effective domestic and international linkages.

Under the urban floriculture, the institute intends to develop 200 floriculture gardens in schools and colleges in seven selected states. The institute targets Kendriya Vidyalayas, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas, Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas and Indian Army Public Schools. In Madhya Pradesh the institute plans to develop 25 school floriculture gardens and in this connection first floriculture garden has been developed at Army Public School, Morar Cantt. Gwalior, MP on 6 January 23. A team of scientists and technical staff including Dr Susheel Kumar (Senior Scientist) and Dr Shankar Verma (Principal Technical Officer) respectively from CSIR NBRI customised the layout for garden preparation and provided the perennial flowering plants. Dr Arvind Kumar Sikarwar, Principal Army Public School Gwalior and 50 students of the school from classes IX to XII did the plantation in the school and contributed to the great mission of Environment Conservation.

#### (M) <u>CYCLOTHON EVENT</u>





## WEBINARS/ WORKSHOPS FOR FACULTY ENRICHMENT


