ANNUAL EXAM PTM FOR CLASSES IX AND XI

(F) PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT SESSION ON PHONETICS AND DICTION

Army Public School, Gwalior organised Faculty Development Workshop on 27th March 2023 from 1130 hours to 1430 hours. The topic was 'Phonetics and Diction' The resource person was Mrs Debolina Chanda, Master Trainer with CELTA British Council. It was attended by all the teachers of APS Gwalior along with five teachers from SAPPS, three teachers from Airforce No.1 School and four teachers from Morning Star School. At the onset of the workshop Dr Arvind Kumar Sikarwar, the School Principal APS Gwalior welcomed the resource person by presenting a sapling. He emphasized upon the need of such workshops for teachers in the present scenario. The resource person apprised all the teachers about the need for the students to know the reason why sounds are important and how they can impact their communication in effective manner. She taught all the basic concepts of Phonetics in a simple way to the teachers. She organised certain group activities to introduce new ideas, inspired participants to further explore it on their own and promote actual practice. At first she divided the teachers in groups and told them to write about their"



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Hopes and Fears" regarding the Phonetics Workshop which they were asked to read at the end of the workshop. She told all the teachers to pronounce certain words containing Voiced, Unvoiced Consonants, Vowels, Diphthongs of English and made the teachers analyse practically whether the sound is produced by their tongue movement, vocal cords, lip movement henceforth made them feel the mechanism of sound production by briefly describing the organs of speech and their mechanism during sound production. She told about the concept of Word Stress, Intonation and made the teachers speak different sentences and give stress at a particular word in the sentence. Hence teachers realised the importance of Stress and Intonation in a sentence. Through PPT presentation and videos she tried to make the workshop lively and more enjoyable. She made the teachers actively participate in correct pronunciation of words by indulging them in a Word Puzzle Activity which was shown on a slide in the PPT. She provided resource material (Chart of All the 44 Phonemes along with their exemplary words) for the teachers which was provided to the teachers in the form of hard copy by APS Gwalior. All the teachers were felicitated by the certificates for attending the workshop. It was a good learning experience for all the teachers to go through the Speech Therapy in the form of Phonetics and Diction Workshop as they got to know the ways in which they can further learn many other important topics of Phonetics in an easy-going manner.

(G) WEBINAR EMBRACING MULTILINGUALISM IN CLASSROOMS

Mrs Renu Tomar (PRT) and Ms. Neelima Tomar (PRT) of APS Gwalior attended an online webinar on 27 March 23 on the subject "Embracing Multilingualism in Classrooms". It was organised by CBSE. The resource person Mrs Neelam Awasthi explained the main objective of the webinar and illustrated how to know more and broaden the horizon of knowledge and get new insights into the reality of using more than one language in an English language classroom. The multilingual, multiethnic and multicultural character of India necessitates the inclusion of several languages in the curriculum for school education. Learning is an



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outcome of various cultural and social factors. Young learners develop it through communication with their surroundings and this can be achieved by embracing local/multi languages in classrooms as per the need. Overall it was a great learning experience for the teachers to know the ways how to cope up with multilingualism in a classroom in a creative manner.



WEBINAR EMBRACING MULTILINGUALISM IN CLASSROOMS

(H) PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT SESSION ON POSCO ACT 2012 &SOFT

In order to ensure safety of the students and create awareness about sexual assault and sexual harassment, Army Public School Gwalior organized an awareness workshop on 'Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act' (POCSO) and Soft Skillson 28 March 2023 for the teachers, in which 65 teachers from the school and 08 teachers from SAAPS participated in it. At the onset of the workshop Dr Arvind Kumar Sikarwar, Principal APS Gwalior welcomed the resource person and expressed his gratitude for facilitating the teachers regarding POCSO ACT. The objective of the workshop was to spread awareness about Child Sexual Abuse and POCSO Act. It was conducted by Captain Moushumi Mukherjee Rana, who spoke in detail about the prevalence of child abuse in our society and emphasized on the significance of identifying symptoms that might be the cause of behavioural changes in students regarding mental or physical abuse within the realms of the society. She reiterated the importance of the role played by educators in the safety and security of children. The teachers were also made aware about the various actions of sexual harassment that are often overlooked and the workshop provided information to all the teachers how to deal with various themes of sexuality; preventive steps to be undertaken; identifying signs of abuse and the relevance of POCSO Act. All the information was imparted in the form of role plays, short videos, activities and discussions. The teachers were motivated to sensitize the students to remain alert about the menace and to freely report to parents and teachers in the event of a problem. She emphasized on the role of schools in playing a proactive role by connecting the children with the awareness process and the laws of POCSO ACT. She also told about the role of teachers to take a lead in the process by acting proactively.

The resource person addressed the topic of Soft skills in the second part of her workshop. She explained that soft skills are the interpersonal and intrapersonal abilities that not only



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help in creating a positive workplace environment but also help an individual stay motivated and increase the productivity of people around them. During the workshop the educators deepened their understanding of Soft Skills and reflected on their own abilities in their macro-areas such as Leadership, Relational Skills, Self-Awareness, Creativity, Problem-Solving and Communication. She discussed about the formal dress code for men and women in schools, colleges and corporate sector and reiterated on the importance of dress code at the workplace. Through hands-on activities that combined these skills, participants learned to transform the prevailing theories of communication, as well as emotional and social intelligence, into practical experiences in their classroom. The session was very interesting, informative and was a great learning experience for one and all.

(J) ONLINE WEB SEMINAR ON EMBRACING MULTILINGUALISM IN CLASSROOM

Mrs.Chanderkala PRT, Army Public School Gwalior, participated in an online session on 'Embracing Multilingualism in Classroom' on 31 March 2023 by COE Bhubaneswar-3. It was organised by CBSE. The resource person Mrs.Lizarani Das, started the session by exploring the truth that no one in this world is just limited to only one language, i.e. one is the mother tongue and other is the community language with which a person deals. She beautifully explained that to have another language is to possess another soul. She also made to understand that though out of 7000 languages in the world, English is the most common second language spoken but sole emphasis on it alone is short sightedness and it reflects rigidness and loss of opportunity. She discussed on the limitations due to traditional thinking on the multilingualism and to overcome it by spreading the awareness of its importance in integration with NEP 2020 to include it in the education system. The Resource Persons of the workshop were Captain Moushumi Mukherjee Rana, an Ex Army Officer and Mr Prashant Nagarch ,trainer in the field of Personality Development and Communication Skills. 40 students of class XI and XII of session 2022-23 attended the workshop.

The workshop aimed to focus at the various stages of NDA and SSB. In the workshop the Resource person discussed about the Eligibility Criteria, Strategy to prepare for written exam, Recommended Physical Activities, Officer like Qualities (OLQS) and Five days schedule of SSB.
