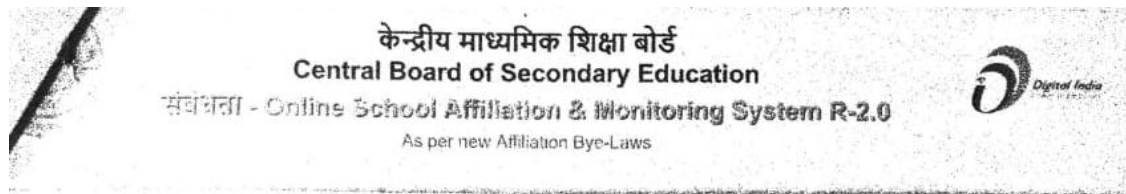

With reference to your application on the subject cited above; I am directed to convey the approval for Extension of General Affiliation as per details given below:-

In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however, the school is pursuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to avoid any difficulty for the purpose of admission /registration/ obtaining loan/renewal of various safety certificates from appropriate state authorities.

Therefore, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on details/data submitted by school in online application for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

1. The school will follow the **RTE Act, 2009** and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
2. The School is required to apply online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
3. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer
4. The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
The school should go through the provision of **Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy there of** for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.
5. The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students. The school will ensure that Fire, Building, health and sanitation and safe drinking water certificates are renewed from time to time, as per norms.
6. **Admission to the school** is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.6.5, 7.1, 7.2, 8.4.2, 8.4.10 & other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.
7. The school is required to follow rule No.2.4.7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Bye Laws regarding Books and Quality of Education.
8. The number of sections may be restricted as per the Appendix V of the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board. For increase in number of sections, the School shall apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of Affiliation Bye laws.
9. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances.
10. The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of campus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environment conservation and cleanliness etc
11. The school shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per details given in circular no. affiliation-06/2018 dated 24.04.2018. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: www.cbse.nic.in
12. The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
13. Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/up-gradation regularly without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
14. Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
15. The Manger and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/ information/data submitted by the School to the Board.
Apart from rules to be adhered to by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-laws and circulars/guidelines/notification issued by the Board from time to time. Any laxity in following rules/instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per clause 12 of Affiliation Bye-laws-2018.
16. The genuineness of information / documents / data submitted shall be of school and in case, if found otherwise the school shall invite action as per affiliation Bye laws-2018
17. The school shall be responsible for submission of any pending compliance, reply of show case /legal notice/ complaint and for submission of date/information sought by the Board. The extension of 05 years shall be from the date of cessation of previous validity of extension of affiliation
18. The school is required to remit pending fee, if any

20. The school shall renew all mandatory safety certificate i.e Safe Drinking Water & Health and Hygiene certificate, Fire Safety Certificate and Building Safety Certificate from concerned Govt authorities time to time

The school shall also maintain record of certificate, compliances, data and other records/information and shall be fully responsible to produce all such records before Board and appropriate Government Authorities when asked for, failing which necessary action shall be taken as per Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board. The school shall also be liable for action by the appropriate Govt., in case of violation / non-compliance of the concerned Govt. norms
22. The Board reserves the right to conduct inspection of school as per clause 11.2 and 11.4 of Affiliation Bye Laws.

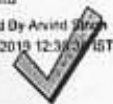

School has to safely keep and maintain all accounts and records of students and staff, the same can be inspected by the departmental officials any time. 5. "Parent-Teacher Association" should be formed to ensure participation of parents of students studying in the school. 6. The school should strive for making continuous efforts to get best academic quality criteria. During each three year period, all teachers should be trained at least once in their respective teaching subjects. 7. Once approved, after due inspection, the Society/Trust will not change any of the parameters claimed at the time of recognition. School Education Department officials can inspect school premises at any time. During inspection, if Society/Trust is found not following declared standards, then Divisional Joint Director can act as given in sub-rule (1) of rule 11, and can suspend school's accreditation. 8. If School is not found to follow conditions and responsibilities given under Rule 5 and 9 as well as instructions and guidance issued by Department from time to time, the undersigned will have the power to suspend the school's recognition on the basis of investigation. 9. In case of any Explanation Call, if the reply received from Society/Trust is not found to be satisfactory, then after giving last hearing opportunity, the school's recognition can be canceled. 10. Upon withdrawal of recognition, Security Fee deposited will be fully or partly, as specified in the order, will be seized. 11. It will be mandatory to get affiliation with the Central Board Secondary Education, and follow all norms as given in CBSE Affiliation Bye-Laws. 12. 1. Firefighting audit has been carried out by a board of officers detailed by Stn HQ convening order No 509/R/Q dt 26 Jul 2021.

FINDINGS OF THE BOARD

2. The board of officers have carried out fire security audit in the school located at Badagaon Chouraha, Morar Cantt, Gwalior and found that school is following adequate fire safety precautionary measures.
- (a) No faulty electric connections have been found. Std wiring, fitting and cut breakers have been found. No electric sockets have been found overloaded. Wire on floor has been protected with or gauge screwed conduit.
- (b) Adequate ventilation in stores. No undergrowth and dry grass have been found in 50 m surrounding area of the school and other stores.
- (c) 33 Nos of fire extinguisher and 16 fire buckets have been found in working condition, which are placed at various places in the school building. Photographs are attached.
- (d) Firefighting drill is being carried out by the school from time to time.
- (e) 04 entry and exit gates are available in the school building.
3. The board recommended the following:-
- (a) All inflammable stores should be kept away from living areas / office areas and other buildings / accn holding stores. Std wiring, fitting and cut breakers will be used.
4. In the opinion of the Board, the school has adequate firefighting equipment and training to overcome any untoward incident and school is following adequate fire safety precautionary measures.

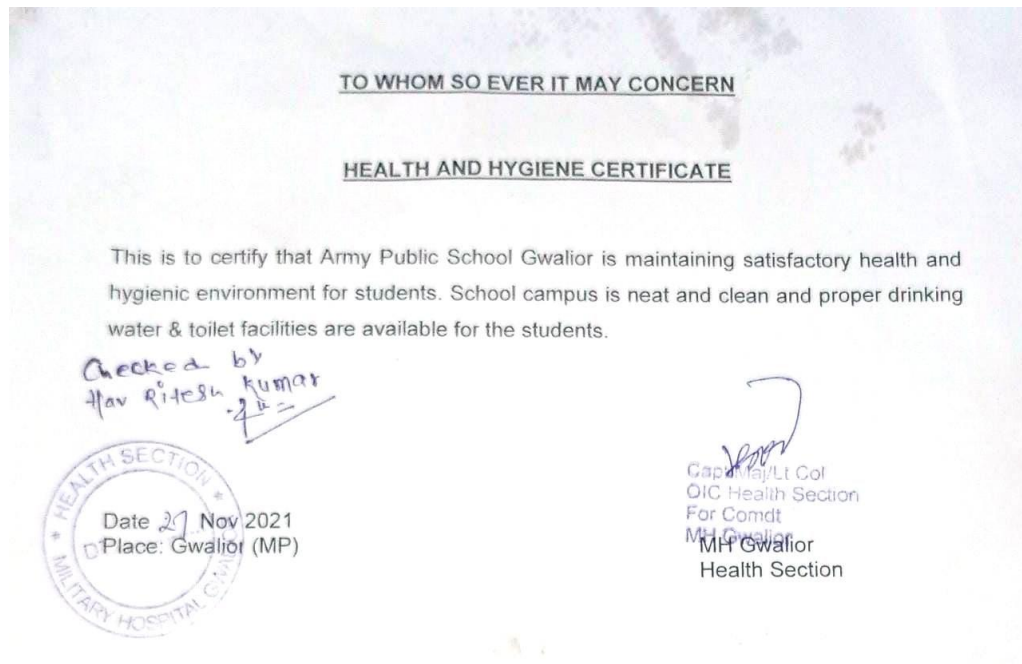
