We see that the ribs are curiously bent. They join the chest bone and the backbone together to form a Box. This is called the rib cage. There are 12 ribs on each side of chest. Some important internal parts of our body lie protected inside this cage. Backboneis made up of many small bones called vertebrae. The backbone consists of 33 Vertebrae. The rib cage is joined to these bones.
