The students showed their interest by interacting actively and presenting themselves in front of their class. She taught them the Basics of Tenses and their applications in Spoken and Writing Skills. It should focus on Parental Involvement, Integrating Technology, Inclusive Learning, Pedagogy, Life Skills Domains to be developed and should contain UDL.Mrs Renu Tomar suggested School Plans for preparing the parents, staff and learners for Seamless Transition. Suggestions for seamless transition were discussed at length. This was an interactive session to update the knowledge wherein the teachers of the two schools going to be amalgamated sat together and discussed and exchanged views for the smooth seamless transition and welfare of the students.











Cyber Safety is the safe and responsible use of information and communication technology. It is not just about keeping information safe and secure, but also about being responsible with that information, being respectful of other people online, and practicing good 'netiquette' (internet etiquette). APS Gwalior organized an Inhouse workshop on the topic Cyber Security on 28 June 23. The session was conducted by Mr Manas Mukherji, TGT Computer Science , APS Gwalior. The workshop aimed to sensitize the teaching staff Regarding Cyber Security Best Practices for Cyber Security , Automatic Backup and its Implementation, Rules, Precautions, its need in present scenario He told the difference between Hacking and Cracking. He introduced many new terms i.e. Social Engineering, Phishing, Cyber Bullying etc.He suggested the teachers to never open unknown files, links and e mails. He sensitized about the risk by showing a video about the Dos and Don'ts while using Cyber Space. He suggested to store confidential data in DVDs and CDs. He told the teachers not to store it online. He told that if mobile phone or computer is getting slow then cleaning is required. If then also it is slow then formatting of the entire system is required. He reminded the teachers if they have provided remote access via computer to someone then log out after using it. While sharing the SOP of Cyber Security he made the teachers aware about the need to be very alert while Online Payment. He advised them to check the website https while doing Online Payment. He reiterated on the need of ensuring password security by making a Strong

and Unique Password. He advised the staff to never use official ID for personal data sharing. He told the teachers not to share official id on Facebook. The staff was instructed not to bring any pen drive, hard disc for any purpose in school. They were advised to upload the E Content/ Teaching Material on the server. The workshop was successful in sensitizing the teachers to keep their data and money safe when cyber bullying cases are galore and Cyber



Security is the only way to escape the threat.



#### **IN HOUSE WORKSHOP ON MIRROR WRITING & CALLIGRAPHY**

An In House workshop was conducted on the topic Mirror Writing, Calligraphy, Dictation, Pronunciation on 30 June 23 in APS Gwalior. Mrs Preeti Sharma elaborated the basic problems of Spelling writing, pronunciation of homophonic words, mispronounced words, words often confused. She suggested the ways which could be followed by the teachers in order to improve their spellings and pronunciation. She discussed about the phonetic complexities of English Language. She demonstrated various ways in which the students can be directed towards English Speaking in a better and improved manner. Overall the workshop became a learning platform for the teachers by means offruitful interaction and creative activities conducted during the activities.






#### **WORKSHOP ON CRITICAL & CREATIVE THINKING**
