GUEST LECTURE ON HUMAN MISSION TO MARS

An Online Guest Lecture was organized on 10 October 23 in APS Gwalior by Kreativity League on Human Missions to Mars: Challenges and Solutions was hosted by Dr. Kshitij Mall, an aerospace scientist at Purdue, USA, a member of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics and post-doctoral research fellow. 80 students of Class XI, Army Public School, Gwalior attended the lecture. The Guest Lecture had a musical start with the hosts playing 1-2 music videos related to space and then students ventured upon an introduction to the planet Mars through a video constituting famous scientists. Moving ahead, Dr. Kshitij enlightened the students about his career trajectory which involved his experiences at NASA and many other achievements. Furthermore, children were given an insight into why Mars plays a significant role in our solar system and how it holds the potential to help humans find our new Home. After that, students were told about the various missions that have been performed by humans and were also made aware of all the challenges that they faced in doing so. After enlightening the students about the challenges to reach Mars and various factors he made them aware about the approaches that were undertaken by NASA and Space X. Besides all that, he also gave his own flying approach and told about his scientific temperament regarding the universe and Mars as a whole. In the end, he showed some photos of the red planet and motivated them to become problem solvers through the means of a

video. Learning about space and Mars itself sparks a scientific behavior inside the minds that makes us curious to decode the mysteries of the universe. This innovative and motivational guest lecture taught many students about aeronautical science and astronomy while injecting them with a curious mind which may even result in leading an individual to become the next astronaut to Mars. This guest lecture indeed proved to be that sparkling light that would light up the fire inside a curious mind.

WEBINAR ON FEEDBACK ON "SAFAL PILOT RESULT SESSION 2

Mr. Manas Mukherjee (TGT Computer) and Mrs Chanderkala (PRT) attended the Webinar on feedback on 'SAFAL Pilot Results' on 13th October from 11300 hrs.to 12000 hrs which was based on successfully digitally conducted SAFAL by CBSE for grade V and VIII from 8 to 23 February 2023 to assess competency-based student learning out comes on the core subjects. It provided the diagnostic data and insights to each school for promoting development of students by focusing on the required areas. The webinar was aimed to know whether the schools have accessed the result if they are able to understand and interpret the SAFAL reports or not. It was told how the reports would help in designing and implementing the improvement plans needed for betterment of schools in the future. The link for filling the feedback on the SAFAL reports was also shared during the webinar which was filled by the teachers on the same day.

Survey for School Heads

An online survey will be administered to school heads of participating schools to understand utility of SAFAL reports for schools and areas where they might require support for creating improvement plans.

Objective of the survey is to understand:

1. Whether schools have accessed and understood the SAFAL reports
2. Whether schools have been able to gain insights on student learning levels, and reflect on high and low performing areas as identified in the SAFAL reports
3. The kind of support schools need to design and implement improvement plans based on insights from SAFAL reports
4. How SAFAL reports can be improved for schools to benefit in the future, and any other feedback

The purpose of the survey is NOT to test schools in any way. It is to understand how SAFAL reporting can be more effective and useful for the schools to plan interventions based on SAFAL data.
