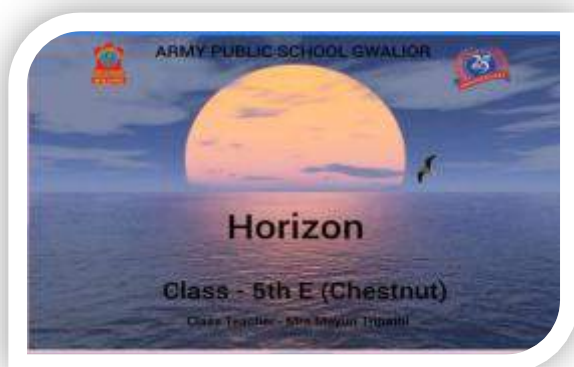




55. E MAGAZINE COMPETITION
