**AMENDMENT IN ARTICLE (ARTICLE 206 TO RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR  
ARMY PUBLIC SCHOOLS, VOL-I (ADMINISTRATIVE)**

1. The Article 206 of Rules and Regulations for Army Public Schools Volume-I (Administrative) Mar 2019), will be replaced as under :-

**Age**

206. **Age Limit.** Where state rules are not being enforced, the age of a student on first admission to various classes in Army Public Schools shall be regulated as indicated below :-



I	6 Years*	8 Years
II	6 Years@	8 Years
III	7 Years	9 Years
IV	8 Years	10 Years
V	9 Years	11 Years
VI	10 Years	12 Years
VII	11 Years	13 Years
VIII	12 Years	14 Years
IX	13 Years	15 Years
X	14 Years	16 Years

\*As per mandate of NEP 2020 entry age for Class I has been revised to 6+ years with effect Academic Session 2023-24

@To avoid disturbance of previous years.

Notes:-

1. The table above shall not be applicable if a student arrives on transfer from a CBSE recognized school with an age not matching the ones given above.
2. **For differently Abled Children.** The maximum age limit can be relaxed by two years in case of Differently abled children by the Principal.
3. There is no age restriction for admission to Class XI provided the student is seeking admission in the year of passing Class X examination. Similarly, there will be no upper & lower age limit for admission to Class XII provided there has been no break in the continuous study of the student after passing Class XI.
4. For the purpose of this clause, it is clarified that those born on 01 Apr of the year shall be considered to have completed the age on 31 Mar of the same year.

This provision has been incorporated to align the admissions in CI-I with the NEP 2020 Directives as promulgated by KVS with effect from Academic Year 2022-23. The same has also been ratified/upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

**AGE CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION IN ARMY PRE PRIMARY SCHOOLS FOR ACADEMIC  
SESSION 2023-24**

1. Further to HQ AWES letter No B/45902/Amdt/APS/AWES dt 08 Feb 2023.
2. In view of implementation of NEP 2020, age for admission to Pre-Primary classes with effect from academic session 2023-24 is as under:-
  - (a) Nursery - Three years as on 01 Apr
  - (b) LKG - Four years as on 01 Apr
  - (c) UKG - Five years as on 01 Apr

**ADVISORY FOR ADMISSION OF CHILDREN IN APSs AND APPSs**

1. Please refer to the following letters of HQ AWES :-
  - (a) B/46001/APPS/AWES dt 30 Mar 2021.
  - (b) B/45767/Misc/AWES dt 11 Mar 2022.
  - (c) B/45902/Admt/APS/AWES dt 08 Feb 2023.
2. Amendment to the age of admission in Class 1 wef AY 2023-24 was issued in accordance with the age criteria for admission as laid down by KVS, which are aligned to NEP 2020. Additionally, the age of admission issued by KVS for Class 1 was upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court. This year, the MoE has also instructed all State and UTs to make 6 years as the min age for admission in Class 1.
3. However, a number of representations are being received from parents whose children are already studying in UKG and had taken admission in Nursery prior to issuance of the letter ref at Para 1 (a) above.
4. In order to provide one time dispensation to the said category, the competent auth has decided to grant a six months waiver to children born between 02 Apr to 30 Sep 2017, for admission in **Class 1 for the Academic Year : 2023-24 only**.
5. For such cases, an affidavit duly notarized should be obtained from the parents to absolve AWES/APS from any detrimental consequence arising from admitting an underage child in APS. Sample of affidavit is attached for ready reference.
6. The amendment issued vide letter ref Para 1 (c) above will now be applicable **from Academic Year : 2024-25 only**.
